About us

Manyara Ranch Conservancy is an enterprise operating in partnership with the Maasai communities in partnership with Monduli District Council and the African Wildlife Foundation.

The Conservancy exists to protect the migration corridors that run between Lake Natron, Ngorongoro Conservation Area, Manyara, Tarangire and Masailand to the South.

Tented Camp Location

Manyara Ranch Conservancy is situated between Tarangire National Park and Lake Manyara National Park within Tanzania's northern circuit.

Getting there by road

- 96 km from Arusha to Manyara Ranch Tented Camp – a 1 ½ hour drive
- 23 km from Manyara Ranch Tented Camp to Tarangire National Park, 30 minutes drive.
- 66 km from Manyara Ranch Tented Camp to Lake Manyara National Park - a 1 hour drive
- 126 km from Manyara Ranch to Ngorongoro Crater floor - a 2 ½ hour drive

Getting there by air

- The closest airstrip is Lake Manyara – a 70 km away - a 1 ½ hour drive
- Arusha airstrip is 85 km away - a 1 ¼ hour drive
- A flight from Arusha airstrip to Manyara airstrip takes 25 minutes

- Wilderness setting
- Classic East African style Safari Camp
- 8 deluxe accommodation tents

- Flush toilets, hot and cold running water
- Generator and inverter fed electricity supply
